



Dr. Sudhakar K. Venkatesh, MD is a **Professor of Radiology** at the Mayo Clinic College of Medicine and Consultant in the Abdominal Division at Mayo Clinic, Rochester, MN, USA. Dr. Venkatesh did his medical school in his hometown Bengaluru in Southern India. He later obtained radiology training in New Delhi, India and in Singapore. He did abdominal fellowship at NUS Singapore and Research fellowship at Mayo clinic. Dr. Venkatesh worked as a faculty at the National University of Singapore, Singapore before he relocated USA.

Dr. Venkatesh has a special interest in liver imaging, particularly chronic liver diseases and has served as chair of the Disease Focus Panel on Liver Fibrosis for the Society of Abdominal Radiology, 2017-2018. He is currently the co-chair for *LIRADS-Quantitative Imaging Group* and co-chair of *LIRADS-cholangiocarcinoma working group*. He has been designated as *Fellow of society of abdominal radiology (FSAR)* and *Fellow of society of advanced body imaging (FSABI)*. He has received several awards and accolades for his research presentations. He has authored and co-authored more than 250 peer-reviewed publications, several book chapters on liver imaging and edited two books and widely recognized as the clinical expert in MR Elastography of the liver and abdomen. Currently he is working on use of multiparametric MR mechanical properties assessment in the understanding of chronic liver disease pathophysiology.
