Dr. Broncano is the Head of the Cardiothoracic Imaging Unit of the company HTmédica, a private imaging network in Spain. He obtained his medical degree at University of Navarre and did his training in radiology at Navarra University Clinic (Pamplona, Spain).

He has published more than 25 manuscripts in peer-reviewed journals. He has delivered more than 100 scientific and educational exhibits at national and international meetings (Radiological Society of North America -RSNA-, Society of Thoracic Radiology -STRE-, European Congress of Radiology -ECR-, European Society of Thoracic Imaging -ESTI-, European Association of Cardiovascular Imaging -EACVI-) being several of them awarded. He has delivered several invited communications on Spanish national (Spanish Society of Radiology-SERAM- and Spanish Society of CardioThoracic Imaging-SEICAT-) and international meetings (Asociación latinoamericana del tórax -ALAT-, ARRS – SERAM congress, North American Society of Cardiac Imaging -NASCI- meeting). Also, he was involved in the chest subcommittee at the ECR and at the thoracic educational exhibit subcommittee at the RSNA congress.
