

BIOSKETCH – Felipe Munera, MD, FASER

Felipe Munera, MD, is a professor of Radiology at the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine, University of Miami Health System (UHealth), Jackson Memorial Hospital, and Ryder Trauma Center. He is fellowship-trained in Body Imaging and Emergency and Trauma Radiology and is board-certified in Diagnostic Radiology. Dr. Munera serves as ER/Trauma Radiology's division director and vice chair of strategy and expansion in the Department of Radiology.

Previously, he held the positions of Director of Imaging Services at UHealth and Vice Chair of Clinical Operations. As an expert in imaging for Emergency, Critical Care, and Trauma patients, Dr. Munera has co-authored over 100 peer-reviewed journal articles and book chapters. He currently serves on the editorial board of Radiology and has previously been on the editorial board of Radiographics.

Dr. Munera is actively involved in several professional societies, including the American Society of Emergency Radiology (ASER), where he is currently President-Elect, as well as the Radiological Society of North America (RSNA) and the American Roentgen Ray Society (ARRS). He has held various leadership roles and served on multiple committees within these organizations. Dr. Munera has lectured extensively both nationally and internationally. He was a member of the Refresher Course Committee for the American Roentgen Ray Society and chaired the scientific program for the ASER meeting in New Orleans. Additionally, he is a fellow of the American Society of Emergency Radiology (ASER).
